What is the purpose of research paper?



- Share knowledge gained with other researchers
- Show how your study fits into current science
- Inform the public about the important scientific activity

Important factors of research writing quality

1) Coherence

- ✓ Include all necessary information in each section
- ✓ Do not repeat information unless necessary

2) Organization

- ✓ Follow IMRD structure
- ✓ Put the right parts in the right place

Important factors of research writing quality

3) Relevance


- Conform to length guidelines and and keep paper focused
- ✓ Choose a limited amount of data to present in each section

4) Clarity

- ✓ Should be easy to read and understand
- ✓ Use proper grammar, phrasing, and style


^{*} Check formatting and style rules of your target journal

THE ANATOMY OF A SCIENTIFIC PAPER





1. INTRODUCTION

What does it do?

- Discusses the problem to be solved
- Describe where your research fits into the science current
- Uses primry literature and summarizes the current understanding of the problem

2. METHODS

What does it do?

- > Tells how you did the study
- Tells what materials and methods of experimentation and analysis were used

3. RESULTS

What does it do?

Explains the important findings of your study that help to answer your research question

4. DISCUSSION/CONCLUSION

What does it do?


- Explains what your findings mean and implication to your area of study and to related fields
- Includes limitations to your study and and discusses possible future research that is needed

Write down your research questions and hypotheses


- "What did this study seek to find?"
- "What are the study's main arguments or questions?"
- "Decide which audience/journal you writing for"
